***A TAG HOLDER MAY HAVE MULTIPLE ENTRIES IN THE TEAM
COMPETITION PROVIDED THEY ARE TEAMED UP WITH A DIFFERENT
TAG HOLDER ON EACH ENTRY. TEAM SCORE WILL BE THE
COMBINED SCORE OF BOTH HUNTERS REGISTERED AS A TEAM.***

- ***A hunter must be entered prior to the start of their season. A team must be entered prior to the start of the earliest season date of its members***
- ***Hunters must provide their tag and hunting license information for recording of season area and dates at the time of registration.***
- ***ALL entry fees must be paid at the time of registration.***
- ***Bucks must be measured within 2 weeks of your season close.***
- ***Antlers and skull (detached from carcass) and punched tag must be presented at the time of measuring.***
- ***No broken skull plates will be measured.***
- ***Measuring will take place each Wednesday 4p-7p at Muley's. Other times may be scheduled by ahead by calling 775-753-7777***
- ***Judges' decision will be final.***

SCORING

Total score will be the combined measurements of A, B-left (SQUARED) +B- right (SQUARED) and C

A: NUMBER OF POINTS ON EACH ANTLER

To be counted a point, the projection must be at least one inch long. All points measured from tip of point to nearest edge of beam as illustrated in Figure 1.

G1's will be counted as a point provided it is at least one inch long.

B: MASS

Circumferences (LEFT AND RIGHT) are taken at the narrowest place as detailed in Figure 2. The smallest place between the burr and the first branch from the main beam. (This measurement is squared and the product of the two sides added to the total score) Spikes will receive a zero score for this measurement.

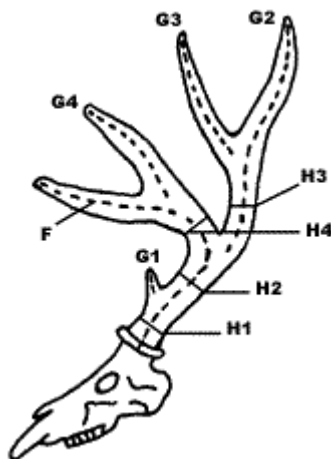
C: GREATEST SPREAD

The greatest spread is measured between perpendiculars at a right angle to the centerline of the skull at the widest part, whether across main beams or points. See Figure 3. C

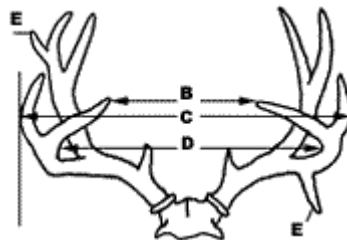

Example: The buck in figure 3 has G-1's over 1". (A) 6 points left and 6 points right. The left base measures 7 1/2" and the right is 8" at the narrowest circumference. The width measurement at -C is 30 1/4".

This buck will score A) 6+6=12. B) Left base circumference is 7.5 x 7.5=56.25 and right base circumference is 8x8=64

Total score for MASS is 56.25+64=120.25 and C) width is 30.25

This buck would score 12+120.25+30.25=162.50
